

Church Re-Opening Update
Sept. 14, 2020

Greetings Members, Friends and Visitors,

Canton Center Church is returning to in-person Sunday services beginning Sept. 20, 2020, at 10 a.m. Here are a few important things to know:

- Our attendance will be limited to 50 people so that we can provide for the required physical distancing in seating.
- Masks are required when inside the church or on the church grounds. They will be available at church if you need one.
- Hand sanitizer is available at the church.
- We are asking our members and regular attenders to please fill out an on-file Covid screening form and send it in to the church office (obtain a form from the office, if you need one), so that when you attend a service, your name can simply be checked off a list. If you have not submitted an on-file form, you will be screened at the door.
- We ask, additionally, that if you plan to attend a Sunday service, you please notify the church office (call or email), so that we will have an approximate count before each Sunday. Notifying us of your plans to attend does not obligate you to attend when the time comes, and you may still attend if you have not notified us.
- There will be no in-person church school this fall for the youngest children, through Gr. 4. In-person church school will be provided for Gr. 5-8 on first and third Sundays of the month.
- Services will be modified to reflect guidance during the pandemic (no hymn-singing, no coffee hours, no hand-shaking, etc.)
- Pew cushions will be removed from the sanctuary for thorough cleaning each week of the pews themselves. Please feel free to bring your own seat cushions if you wish.

As we return to in-person services, we are committed to continuing the life of our church while making the modifications necessary for everyone's safety and will continually monitor any needed changes. We appreciate everyone's cooperation.
